- 5.03 We have received a quote of £1162 for studio hire for our next production. We may need to amend times nearer the date of the show.
- 5.04 Have received a couple of queries from potential new members through the website. JM to send them further information. Diane indicated that she has a friend who may be interested in joining.

6. PRESS and PUBLICITY

- 6.01 Website still being worked on and updated. NODA photos need putting onsite.
- 6.02 Carolyn reported she is now in a position to launch the next show online.

8.01 Gillian reported that we have made a loss of £616 on The Great Gatsby. Tickets sales were disappointing. It was an expensive show to stage but it did come in on budget.

Have received a quote for the hire of the studio. This was received before the prices went up

9.02 The Blurb and image of Santa and a Christmas tree was submitted before the brochure deadline

Both JM and CC have been emailing to get confirmation

- 9.03 CC is working on the flyer and poster design and this will be submitted for approval and then printed materials ordered in readiness for the Summer Social.
- 9.04 People have been approached regarding the technical support and we are currently awaiting confirmation.

- 9.05 We have a digital copy of the updated version of the script available to send out. (Licence obtained)
- 9.06 Leah has been working on booking rooms at The Playhouse
- 9.07 Launch Wednesday June 18th and Tuesday July 8th for auditions JM and CC to be on audition panel and hopefully the SM when appointed. Details to be sent out as soon as possible to contacts list and put on line for open auditions.
